Forty percent of the drug reaches the blood in the first 30 seconds. Relief has been reported within 2 hours.

Because there is no THC in the hemp oil, urine drug tests are negative. It is available over-the-counter – no card or prescription needed – in 30 and 50 ml sizes lasting about 15 to 60 days depending on patient response.
